In May, Nicky worked in a remote indigenous village in the mountains near Minatitlan, Veracruz. He worked with a team from **Rio Rancho, NM**, four men from Juárez, as well as Cruz Velasquez and David Quiñones.

He forwarded funds that he had recieved that were designated for an indigenous church; and the pastor was able to have a foundation put in and walls put up. The Rio Rancho team provided funds for the roof.

Traveling about 3,800 miles, they made the trip in 10 days. That included 4 and 1/2 days of work and half a day to play at the waterfall shown above.
